To sno-cross / cross-country enthusiasts,

Here is the 1st racing bulletin... You will receive the next one during Christmas time.

Our race season will start in FALARDEAU, at VALINOUEÛ Ski Resort, Friday December 18th, 2009, with practice from 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. . On Saturday December 19th, it will be a regular race program.

PRO & SEMI-PRO REGISTRATION FEE

As we instigated last year, **THIS YEAR AGAIN**, in **PRO & SEMI-PRO** categories, there will not be any registration fee. Administration fees only will be collected by **S.C.M.X.** . **PRO & SEMI-PRO** drivers will not be reimbursed for the gate admission fee. **(IN THE OTHER CATEGORIES, THE GATE ADMISSION FEE WILL BE REIMBURSED TO THE DRIVER.)**

JUNIOR 14 - 17

After the conclusive experimentation by **S.C.M.X.** last year, the new **I.S.R.** rule (2009 - 2010 International Snowmobile Racing Yearbook, p. 122,), for the **JUNIOR 14 - 17**, reads:

Designated snowmobiles: 600cc stock fan cooled snowmobiles, 600cc stock liquid cooled snowmobiles, Super Stock 600 qualified models may be used with manufacturers provided throttle limiter controls set at ISR approved throttle opening levels. This specification may change from time to time as additional limitations may be required.

Those interested MUST buy this throttle limiter control from the race department of the manufacturer of their snowmobile.

HELMET

In the 2009 - 2010 **I.S.R.** **YEARBOOK**, page 16, 1st column, number 2:

Full coverage helmets are mandatory. Helmets will be full protective coverage and carry the **2005 Snell** Foundation Approval Code. **Helmets carrying European Standard ECE 22.05 are also approved.**

NOTE: Snell 2000 (or before) are not accepted. This is also mandatory in the tune-up area. The helmet must be securely fastened at all times.

In the 2009 - 2010 **I.S.R.** **YEARBOOK**, page 16, 1st column, number 4:

The helmet must be predominantly blaze or international orange in color. More than 50% of its entire outer surface including the visor must be orange. A template measuring 2 inches by 3 inches placed anywhere on the helmet must contact orange color. On a typical snocross helmet there should be at least 144 square inches (12 x 12 inches) of orange.

REMINDER: In the 2009 - 2010 I.S.R. YEARBOOK, page 16, 1st column, number 5:

At least 144 square inches of visible area on both the driver's front and back will be international or blaze orange in color.

BIB NUMBERS

If you did not reserve your bib number, call Lynda Fortin at 418 679-5834.

Bib number must be displayed on both sides of the sled, black numbers on a white lining, minimum height is 6 inches. Another very visible location is under the belly pan between the skis.

S.C.M.X. & ROCK MAPLE RACING (RMR) AGREEMENT

S.C.M.X. and RMR renewed their reciprocal agreement about driver's membership. If a S.C.M.X. member races at a RMR event, RMR will accept the S.C.M.X. membership. Whenever a RMR driver (U.S. resident) will race at a S.C.M.X. event, S.C.M.X. will accept the RMR membership.

RADIO (C.B.) COMMUNICATION

In the 2009 - 2010 I.S.R. YEARBOOK, page 72, 1st column, number 9:

Radio communication between crew and driver not allowed. Individual circuits may allow radio communication to PRO drivers only. S.C.M.X. will allow radio communications to PRO drivers.

2009 - 2010 POINTS SYSTEM

In the qualifying race, the winner will get 10 points, 2nd = 9, 3rd = 8, 4th 7, etc.

In the last chance race, no points are given.

In the final race, the winner will get 25 points, 2nd = 23, 3rd = 22, 4th = 21, etc.

At the end of the race season, to get money from the points championship, the driver WILL HAVE TO RACE AT EVERY RACE DAY.

Driver's committee may decide not to penalize a driver who miss a race day because of serious injuries.

In the 120 c.c. class, we will offer 2 classes: 6 years and younger and 7 years and older.
